These are just a few of the sensory experiences you can have while you are at Tenaflly Nature Center. On your next visit, explore the trails and see what other things you can experience with your senses.

<p>1 VISITOR CENTER</p> <p>You may touch the antler from a deer. What does it feel like? Is it smooth or rough? What do you think they are used for?</p> 	<p>2 POLLINATOR GARDEN</p> <p>Find two different flowers in bloom and smell them. Do they smell the same? Why do you think flowers smell like that?</p> 	<p>3 AVIARY</p> <p>How many birds do you see? Are they the same? Can you see them sitting on one foot? How long can you stand on one foot?</p> 	<p>4 EAGLE NEST</p> <p>Do you hear the leaves making sounds? Are there any leaves on the ground? What sound do they make when you step on them?</p> 
		<p>5 YELLOW TRAIL</p> <p>Find a tree with horizontal lines (from side to side). Scrape your fingernail across its smallest branch. What does it smell like?</p> 	<p>6 FLOATING DOCK</p> <p>Look at the trees and leaves. How many colors do you see? Are they bright or dark? Are they different shades of the same color?</p> 
<p>7 FAERIE TRAIL</p> <p>How many fairy houses can you find as you walk along the trail? What are they made from? Are they the same or different?</p> 	<p>8 RED TRAIL</p> <p>Listen! Can you hear running water? That is the East Brook which flows and connects Pfister's pond to the Hackensack Watershed.</p> 		
<p>9 DE FILIPPI SHELTER</p> <p>Can you hear the sounds of birds? What kind of sound are they making? Can you do an impression of the calls you hear?</p> 	<p>10 WHITE TRAIL</p> <p>Touch the rocks at the large outcrop. How rough are they? Are they smooth? Rocks like these were made from magma.</p>
